## **PCC KEY MESSAGES**

A fulsome PCC meeting last month included the following highlights;

- Chris Sampson presented his work as Worship Director so far and his vision for the year ahead. There was universal support and appreciation for the great achievements of the past year. Chris noted that he has aimed to ground worship in the life of community and prayer.
- Hilary Hayes presented a few options for a church weekend away and the PCC agreed to work towards a Lee Abbey visit in late 2024.
- The PCC agreed to improve the Scout Hut in order to make it suitable for serving refreshments in a cafe style environment. Plans include clearance, cleaning and painting and some work on the floor. The next stage is for a proposal to be worked on by the Standing Committee to get clear and budgeted proposals for the PCC's approval.
- Ian Pinder presented a financial update which indicated that the rates of Christian Giving are up 20% compared with Q3 2022.
