# A Note From **Your Vicar**

I remember my first Easter as a Vicar. It was pretty intense to be honest. I was doing a lot of the preaching and I got so wrapped up in it, I remember sitting crouched on my seat, hoodie-hood over my head enraptured with the dramatic events.

Why was that first one so intense? I'd been a Christian for a long time, I'd gone to church. Even as a tiny kid when we didn't go to church, I was told we had to wait till Easter for the chocolate eggs to be eaten but never got the big deal. I'd orbited Easter, sort of done a bit of it, eaten the lamb, eaten all of the chocolate but somehow had missed the Easter journey itself.

I once read that Donald Trump watches movies really quickly by skipping all of the dialogue and jumping straight to the action sequences...and whilst it's possible to read the last page of a book, read a plot summary online or skip straight to dessert, you're probably missing something quite big. If you only want to see the big 'moments' of a story then the plot won't make much sense to you.

We know the story of Easter. We know how it finishes and where it's ending up. But...skipping to the end and losing the middle bits, you're missing out, I know I was for many years and I don't think that's an uncommon experience today.

On **Thursday** we have our Maundy Thursday Meal that begins with communion, has a meal in the middle and then ends with the stripping of the church. The mood changes as once the mood changed in another upper room and we'll shift from celebrating and feasting to the sobriety of a candlelit church slowly turning to darkness.

On **Friday**, we take time at the cross at 10.30 before joining in with the worship in the town centre from 12.00. Our Chris is leading a day of prayer and worship at North Street

On **Saturday**, all ages are welcome to join the Easter celebrations with open fires to toast buns, escape rooms for the teens and lots of activities for the family.

Then on **Easter Sunday**, we greet the new sunrise with worship at 6.30 before joining in big celebrations at our normal times of 9.30 and 11.00. Most of you reading this have 'done' Easter before. You've been to celebrations, hunted for eggs and eaten the big meal but this year, why not enter in to the journey in a deeper way, enter in to the whole Easter journey and see what you find.

I promise you'll be rewarded.

#### **PURSUIT DAY OF PRAYER**




