I have three kids at different ages. My youngest is much younger and one of the joys of being the tiniest ones is inheriting the toys of the older generation. It means it's a bit like Christmas every few months as another developmental stage is reached and then different toys become fun.

Recently, a toy helicopter found it's way out of some storage corner of the house. It was one of those marvellous tovs which was reasonably priced from a really big Tesco which packed far more into it's price tag than you would think. The rotary blades used to turn (the three that remain) with a whirring electronic sound, there were lights on the front and side, the cockpit opens and the side doors also open. It even has a winch action which can be operated by a lever. This is a lot of toy to pack into £10. But tenish years later it is showing it's age. The battery compartment had broken and has been thrown away somewhere and the age of the toy made it look a bit like a toy destined for the tip.

Playing with the youngest one, I was struck by a brain wave....what if? I found some batteries, then covered up the broken compartment with gaffer tape so that she can't consume any rogue AAs. Suddenly, the toy was restored. Whirring blades, winch and lights. We even got the winch to pick up a ukelele...then I was on a roll. I found an old rubbish truck which was similarly endowed, a screw driver, some batteries and more gaffer tape. 
### Friday 21 June
